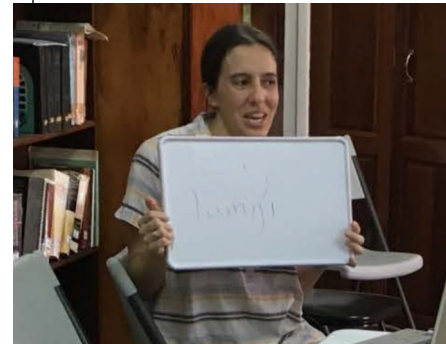

Grab An Envelope!

The envelopes displayed in the hanging pockets in the foyer are up for grabs! Here's how it works:

- Each envelope has a number on the front, which represents a dollar amount;
- Choose an envelope bearing the number of the amount you'd like to sacrificially give;
- Do without something you normally don't (cup of coffee, family meal out, weekend/annual vacation);
- Place the money you saved in the envelope, and write your name on the back label;
- Drop the envelope in the offering plate, office drop box, or bowl at the front of the First Family noon meal buffet line.
