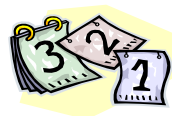

Nursery Needs

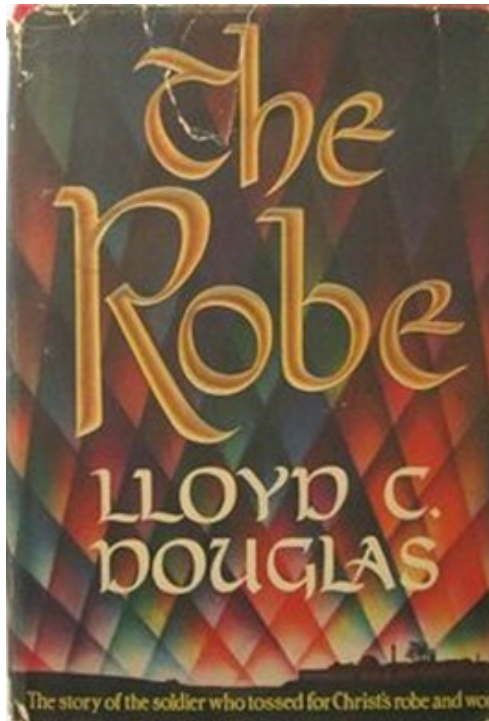
