Dear Friends & Family: Thank you for thinking of us and praying for us as Hurricane Irma heads our direction. We are trusting God to keep us safe and praying constantly for His mercy and that He would turn the hurricane back out to sea. Nearly a year ago we boarded up our home the first time and left the area with Hurricane Matthew—God was gracious and moved it at the very *last hour*, keeping Orlando from taking the brunt of it. Roads are already jammed and gas stations are struggling to keep up with the demand due to mandatory evacuations. We are praying about whether or not we should try to get out, or hunker down and stay here. Barry is working today but will be off tomorrow to make preparations. Cry out with us for God's mercy on Florida and the Islands—That He would supernaturally move—or break up the storm—or that He would protect us in the midst of it should He allow it to continue. We know our home belongs to Him. We are praying for all who've already been devastated by Irma. We choose to praise Him. Pray that we would stand firm and wait, hope and expect!
